

RESOLUTION NO. 7-2010

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF TRAPPE DESIGNATING THE TOWN CLERK, THE ZONING ADMINISTRATOR AND THE TOWN PLANNER AS THE INDIVIDUALS AUTHORIZED BY THE TOWN OF TRAPPE TO REVIEW ADULT ORIENTED BUSINESS APPLICATIONS AND TO EITHER ISSUE A LICENSE OR DENY SUCH APPLICATIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 20.00 OF THE TOWN CODE

WHEREAS, on August 4, 2010, the Town of Trappe adopted Ordinance 6-2010 which amended the Trappe Town Code to add Section 20.00 to regulate Adult Oriented Businesses within the Town of Trappe in order to promote public health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, Section 20.3 of the Town Code provides that an applicant for an Adult Oriented Business license shall file a completed application with the Town and Section 20.4 provides that within twenty (20) days of the filing date of a completed application, the Town shall either issue the license or issue a letter of intent to deny the application; and

WHEREAS, the Council of Trappe believes that it is desirable and in the public interest to designate the employees or staff of the Town of Trappe who will review and either issue or deny the Adult Oriented Business license applications.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF TRAPPE AS FOLLOWS:

1. An application for an Adult Oriented Business shall be reviewed by the Zoning Administrator, the Town Planner, and the Town Clerk. If the application satisfies all of the requirements of Section 20.00 of the Town Code, the license issued by the Town for such use shall be signed by the Town Clerk, the Zoning Administrator and the Town Planner certifying compliance with the Town Code. If the application does not comply with the provisions of the Town Code, the same individuals shall issue a letter of intent to deny the application, including the reasons for the denial.

2. Upon receipt of the application for an Adult Oriented Business, the Town Clerk shall send a copy of the application to the Planning Commission and the Council of Trappe for informational purposes. A copy of the issued license or letter of intent to deny an application shall also be provided to the Planning Commission and the Council.
