



TOWN OF TRAPPE BULK TRASH REGULATIONS

(Adopted June 02, 2010)

The Town of Trappe will collect bulk trash from residential properties within the Town of Trappe on Friday July 30, 2010 and thereafter on the last Friday of October and the last Friday of April of each year, as well as on dates determined by the Town Council, in accordance with the following policies and regulations.

All bulk materials to be picked up for disposal must be scheduled in advance. A bulk collection fee of \$5.00 payable in advance will be collected for each residential bulk pickup not to exceed 3 cubic yards ($\leq 3 \text{ yd}^3$), [about a pickup truck load] per residence. To arrange for pick up, residents must call the Town Office at least three (3) days before the scheduled pickup date. 410-476-3170

Large load, over-size or over-weight item – Residents with a large debris pile ($> 3 \text{ yd}^3$), debris from move-outs or evictions, automobiles, concrete, brick or other masonry rubble, or over-size or over-weight items should call the Town Office at least one (1) week before the scheduled pickup and before placing the item(s) for pickup to find out if these items can be accepted. A determination will be made by Town officials and the trash hauling contractor. Oversize loads, if accepted, will surcharged based on loading, hauling and disposal costs.

All materials to be collected must be generated by the resident at that property, not by contractors. Materials are NOT to be transferred from other properties, inside or outside of the Town of Trappe.

Bulk materials will not be collected from businesses or other non-residential properties.

Cardboard boxes must be broken down and bundled (max 10 boxes per bundle) limited to 3 bundles. (Cardboard boxes will also be picked up with regular garbage.)

Broken glass should be wrapped in paper and marked as broken glass.

Sharp objects must be placed in metal or hard plastic containers with lids (eg. laundry detergent bottles).

Leaves must be dry and must be in tied bags or placed in covered containers (not over eight bags per household). Wet leaves will not be collected. Dry leaves in bags or covered containers may also be placed for regular weekly trash pickup. The town recommends that residents mulch their leaves.

Sticks must be tied in bundles not more than (3) feet long and not more than sixty (60) pounds.

Tree limbs must not be more than six (6) inches in diameter and not more than (3) feet long and not more than sixty (60) pounds.

Christmas trees only will be picked up in January.

Boards, posts, etc. shall not be longer than 3 ft (36") or more than 60 pounds..

Loader piles of vegetative bulk will NOT be picked up.

Rugs must be dry and rolled up and tied or folded and tied.

No more than one (1) each, hot water heater, refrigerator, freezer, or stove will be picked up per residence.

Refrigerators, freezers, and air conditioners must have Freon gas removed. Refrigerator and freezer doors and lids must be removed. Freon is required by law to be recovered by a licensed HVAC technician and may not be vented into the atmosphere. The trash hauling contractor will require proof that that Freon has been removed from refrigeration appliances before pickup.

Water-soaked debris will NOT be picked up.

Gas engine driven equipment (lawn mowers, chain saws, generators, leaf blowers, weed eaters, etc.) must have all oil and gas removed from the tanks before disposal.

Metal items must be separated from other debris and yard waste.

Residential tire pickup will be limited to 4 tires per household per pickup.

Surcharged: (in addition to the \$5.00 per residence pickup charge)

Passenger Tires (tire size < 15")

\$3 per tire w/out a rim and clean

\$6 per tire on the rim or dirty

Light Truck Tire and Passenger Tires (tire size > 15")

\$4.25 per tire w/out a rim and clean

\$8.50 per tire on the rim or dirty

No Heavy Truck Tires (tires size 9.0 and up)

No Off the Road (OTR) Tires.

Other Prohibited items include

- Antifreeze
- Asbestos
- Concrete, brick or masonry rubble
- Contractor's waste
- Dead animals
- Demolition debris
- Explosives and ammunition
- Hazardous materials

- Items belonging to someone else
- Items prohibited at the Landfill
- Motor oil
- Paint cans with anything in them
- Propane tanks
- Tree stumps soil/mulch

Small items, toys, old lamps, electronics, cardboard boxes, small appliances, bagged dry leaves, small bundles of sticks, empty paint cans, and the like may also be placed for the regular weekly trash pickup. If in doubt, call the town office.

Items placed for bulk pickup shall be placed near the street not more than four (4) days before a scheduled pickup date. Items shall not be placed on the sidewalk, in the gutter, or on the traveled portion of the street.

Refused items – Items that cannot be legally disposed of in the landfill will not be picked up. The trash hauling contractor may refuse any item(s) when in his judgment the item cannot be safely loaded, transported, and legally disposed of.

Alternative disposal – Tires, bedding, refrigerators, washing machines, dryers, water heaters, and large household furnishings and appliances are usually accepted for disposal by the store when a new item is purchased.
